ORDER AND REASONS

Before the Court is plaintiff Freddie Bawoo Zayzay's motion to indefinitely continue all scheduling deadlines until plaintiff's counsel has completed discovery on the issue of BP's failure to conduct dermal monitoring and biomonitoring, and his motion to continue the submission date for defendants' motion for summary judgment for similar reasons.¹

The Court denies plaintiff's motions. As noted in the Court's Order and Reasons granting summary judgment to defendants, plaintiff has not pointed to any admissible expert opinions that would allow him to sustain his burden on causation. Evidence showing that BP improperly failed to conduct dermal monitoring and biomonitoring would not cure the defect in plaintiff's case.
